OS and Software Version

Video file type: H264 .mp4

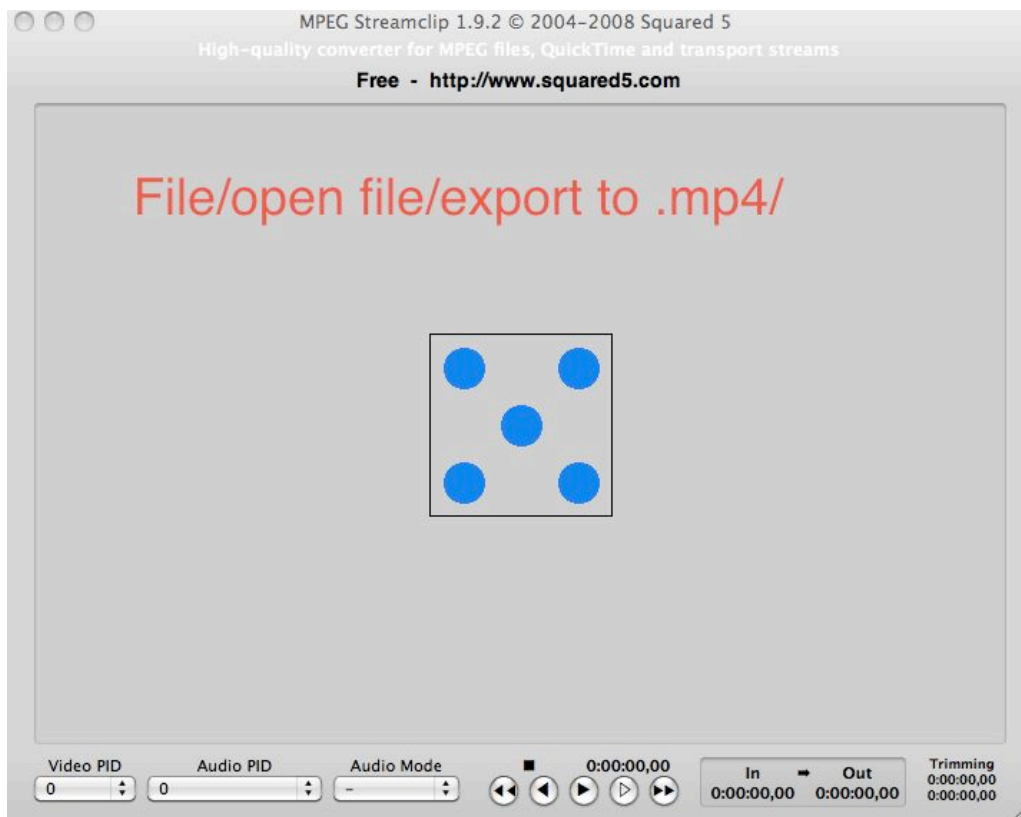
Video conversion tools:

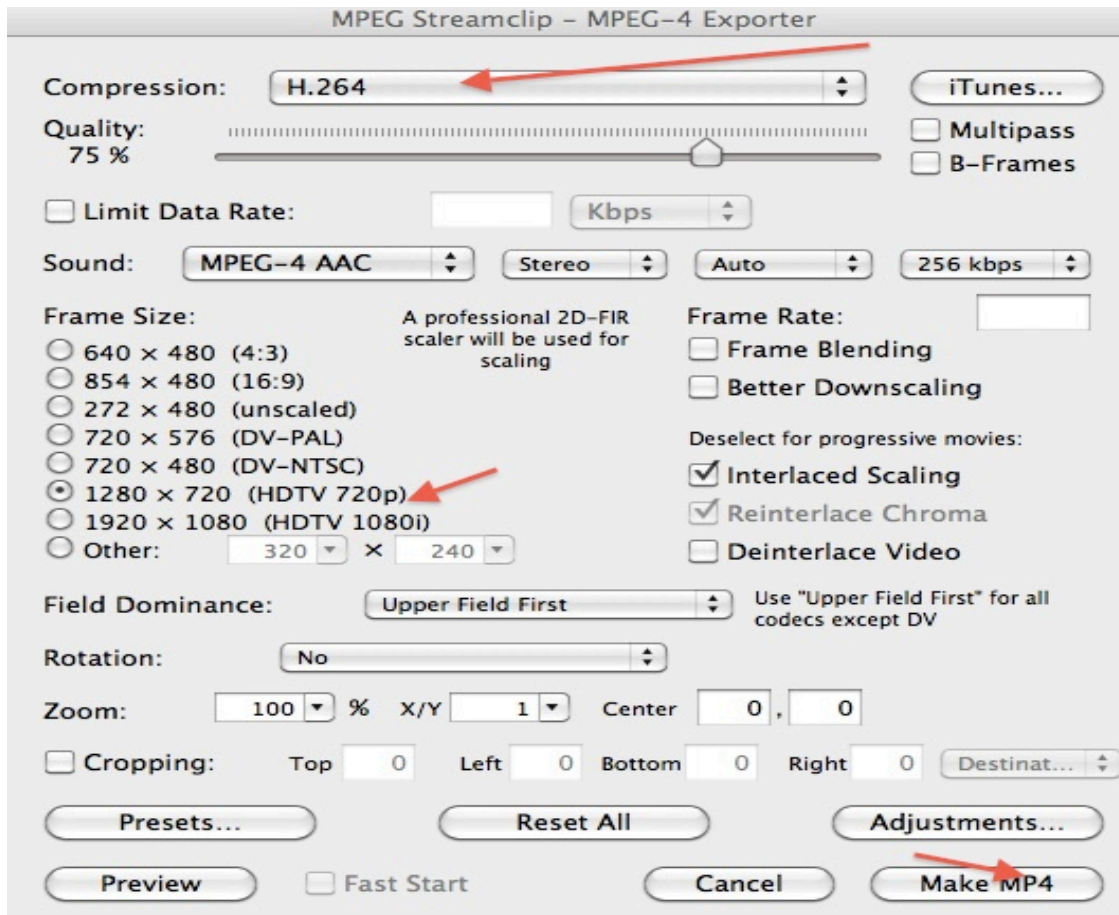
It is highly recommended you convert all video files to H.264 .mp4 format before uploading. This is a quick process with the right tools!

For both Mac and PC:

Mpeg Stream Clip to convert .mp4 to H.264 .mp4

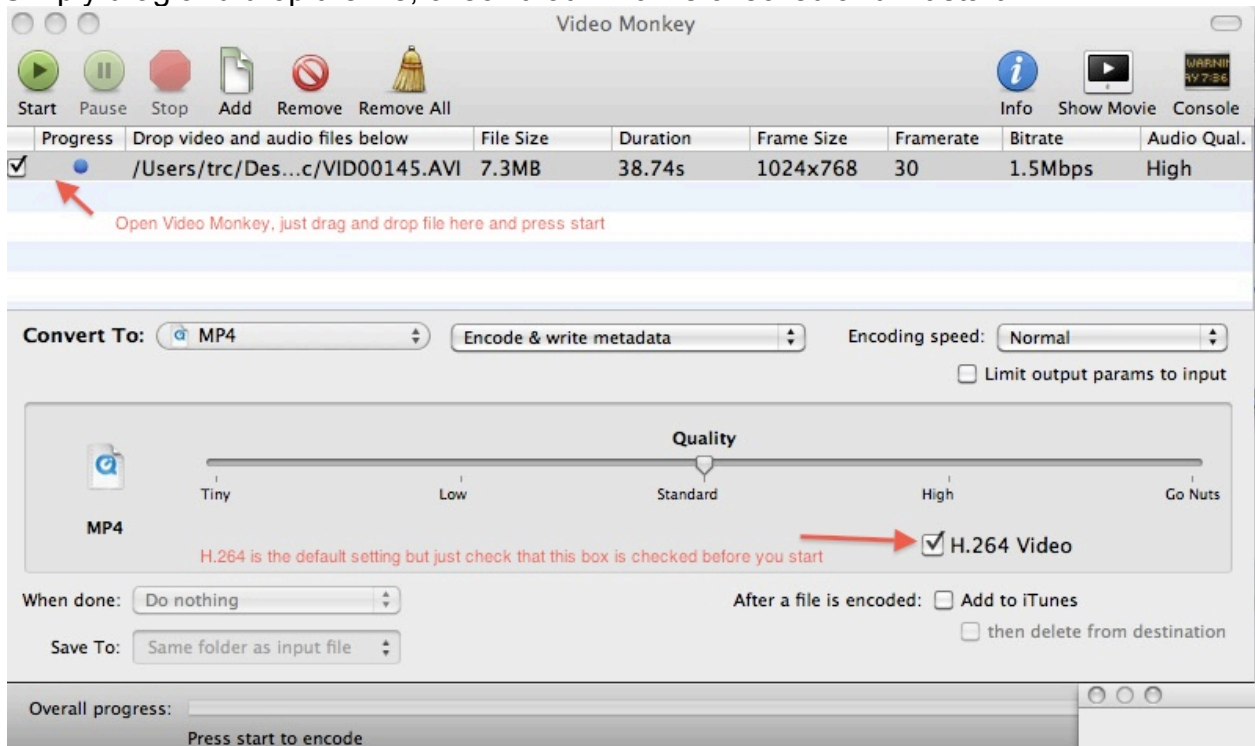




For Mac only

VideoMonkey to convert files for all file conversions including .mp4 – H.264 .mp4
 Download application from <http://videomonkey.org/Downloads/index.html>
 Requires 10.6.8 or higher

Simply drag and drop the file, check that H.264 is checked and hit start

1. Download and convert to .mp4 via

2. Use Mpeg Stream Clip or VideoMonkey to change the codec to H.264
